### MEDINA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT JANUARY 29, 2007 9:00 A.M.

### ITEM #1 MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

County Judge James Barden called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and noted that all members were present.

## ITEM #2 DISCUSS AND CONSIDER APPROVAL OF JANUARY 22, 2007 MINUTES

#### **ITEM #8**

DISCUSS AND CONSIDER FINAL APPROVAL TO STAR CROSSING SUBDIVISION (FORMERLY CARROLL CATTLE CO.) LOCATED IN PRECINCT 3 OFF OF CR 683 (JOHN HOWARD, SURVEYOR)

John Howard presented Court Members a final plat consisting of 29.72 acres including 17 lots sizing 1 ½ - 2 acres off of CR 683.

#### ITEM #9

DISCUSS AND RECONSIDER PURCHASE OF AUTOMOBILES FOR SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT (SHERIFF RODRIGUEZ)

Sheriff Rodriguez presented the Court Members a breakdown of costs for the 5 vehicles to be purchased. Base price \$109,815 from McKinney plus an additional \$7185.50 for the necessary radio, decals and controllers to be installed making the total cost of \$116,990.50. See attachment.

# ITEM #10 DISCUSS AND CONSIDER CONTRACT WITH TEXAS ADJUDICATED PLACEMENT SERVICES INC. FOR POST ADJUDICATED SERVICES

The proposed contract between Medina County and the Texas Adjudicated Placement Services, Inc. in Carrizo Springs is for securing a juvenile post adjudicated facility for both males and females, if the need should arise. The contract is for one (1) year and can be terminated by either party with twenty-four (24) hours notice. The fee for services is eighty-eight dollars (\$88.00) per day per male and ninety-four dollars (\$94.00) per day per female juvenile. Charges will begin to accrue regardless of the day and hour admitted, and will include the day released. (See attachment)

After review, a motion was made by Commissioner Carroll and second by Commissioner Keller to approve the Post-Adjudicated Services Contract for both males and females with Texas Adjudicated Placement Services, Inc.. Motion carried.
