President Manuel Rodriguez called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. A quorum was established with Commissioner's Manuel Rodriguez, Maria Sanchez, Linda Rodriguez, and Elizabeth Cargile present.

2. PUBLIC HEARING -BUDGET AND TAX RATE COMMENTS:

RECOGNITION AND WELCOME OF CITIZENS:

A. Discussion and action on the adoption of the 2023 ty / 2024 fy budget.

Budget Officer Cargile submitted the adopted proposed budget from the August 17th meeting for further review and final adoption by the BOESC.

<u>MOTION:</u> Commissioner Linda Rodriguez moved to adopt the 2024 fiscal year budget as submitted, second by Commissioner Maria Sanchez. Being no discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

B. Discussion on the adoption of the Maintenance and Operations and the Interest and Sinking rates for the 2023 tax year. Commissioner Cargile submitted the proposed 2023 tax rate as set forth at \$0.10/\$100.00 value.

The 2023 proposed tax rate is based on the NNR/VAR/DMR worksheets received from the Medina County Tax Assessor - Collector for Medina County Emergency Services District No. 5.

MOTION: Commissioner Cargile "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100.00 valuation". Second by Commissioner L. Rodriguez. _Discussion-Commissioner Cargile stated that "the tax rate will effectively be raised by 34.77 percent and will raise taxes for Maintenance and Operations on a \$100,000.00 home by approximately \$15.00. Furthermore, in accordance with the Texas Tax Code \$26.05 this will establish the District's ad valorem tax rate for the 2023 tax year as follows: Debt rate of 0.0181/\$100 and a maintenance and operations rate of 0.0819/\$100 for a maximum allowed rate of \$0.10 per \$100.00 valuation of the appraised value. Per the tax code \$26.05, all taxes raised by said rate will be used to fund the maintenance, operations and outstanding debt expenditures of the Medina County Emergency Services District Number 5 for the 2024 fiscal year".

Being no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

6. REPORT FROM TREASURER:

A. Treasurer Linda Rodriguez submitted the QuickBooks presentation of M&O and I&S accounts and spreadsheets are attached. Auditor sent Medina County Judge Lutz a status letter that the MCESD#5 audit should be finalized in the next 2-3 weeks.
