Discussion-Secretary Cargile inquired if members of our service providers (NVFD or LVFD) had any information to share or input on specific banks. LVFD member Logan Medina stated that the Lytle VFD recently moved all accounts from the TXN to Lytle State bank because of poor customer service. No further discussion, Motion to open a new account in LSB passed unanimously.
